by year, 2005-06 to 2015-16**

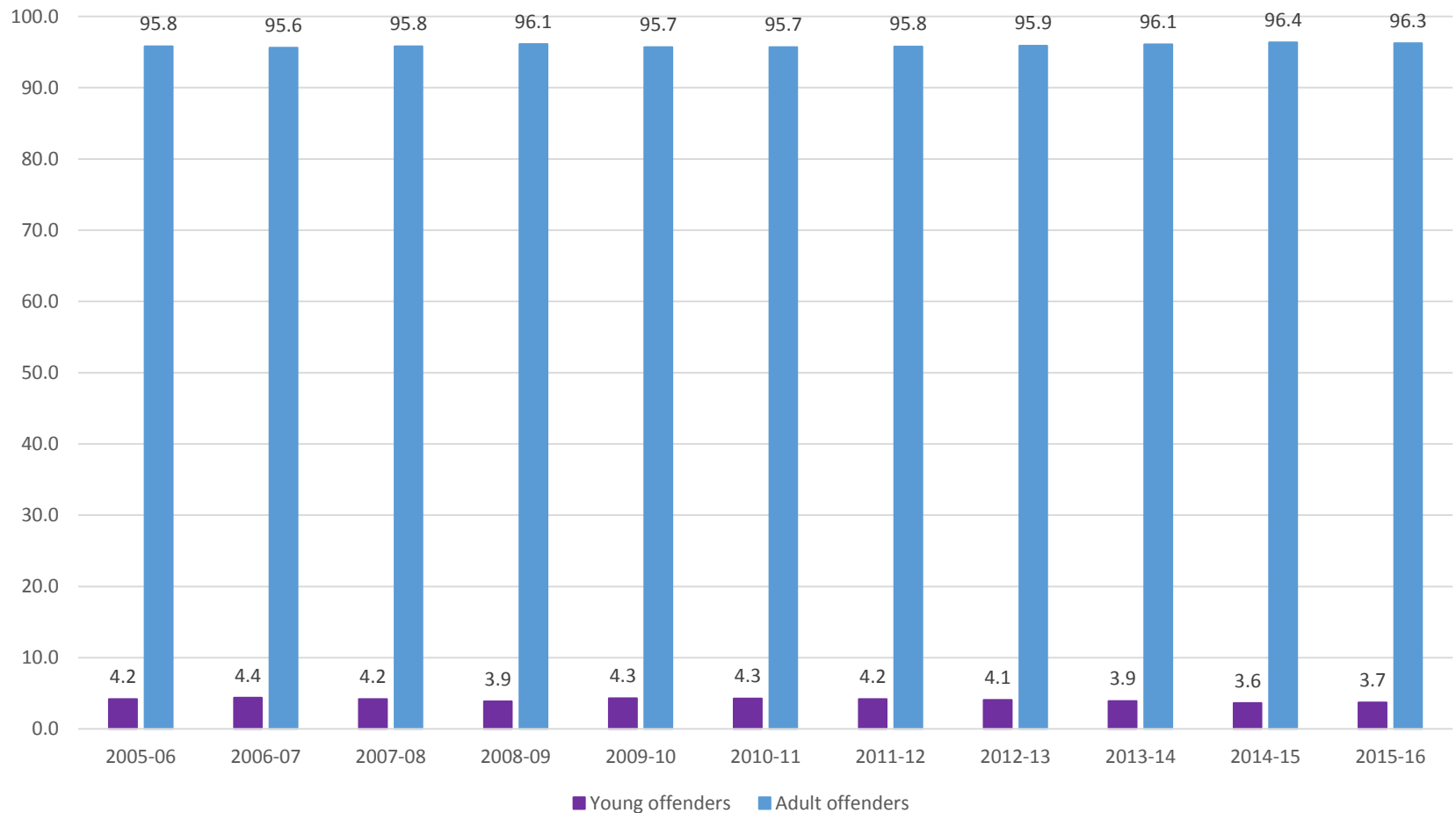


Figure 2: Sentenced young offenders by gender and year, 2005-06 to 2015-16

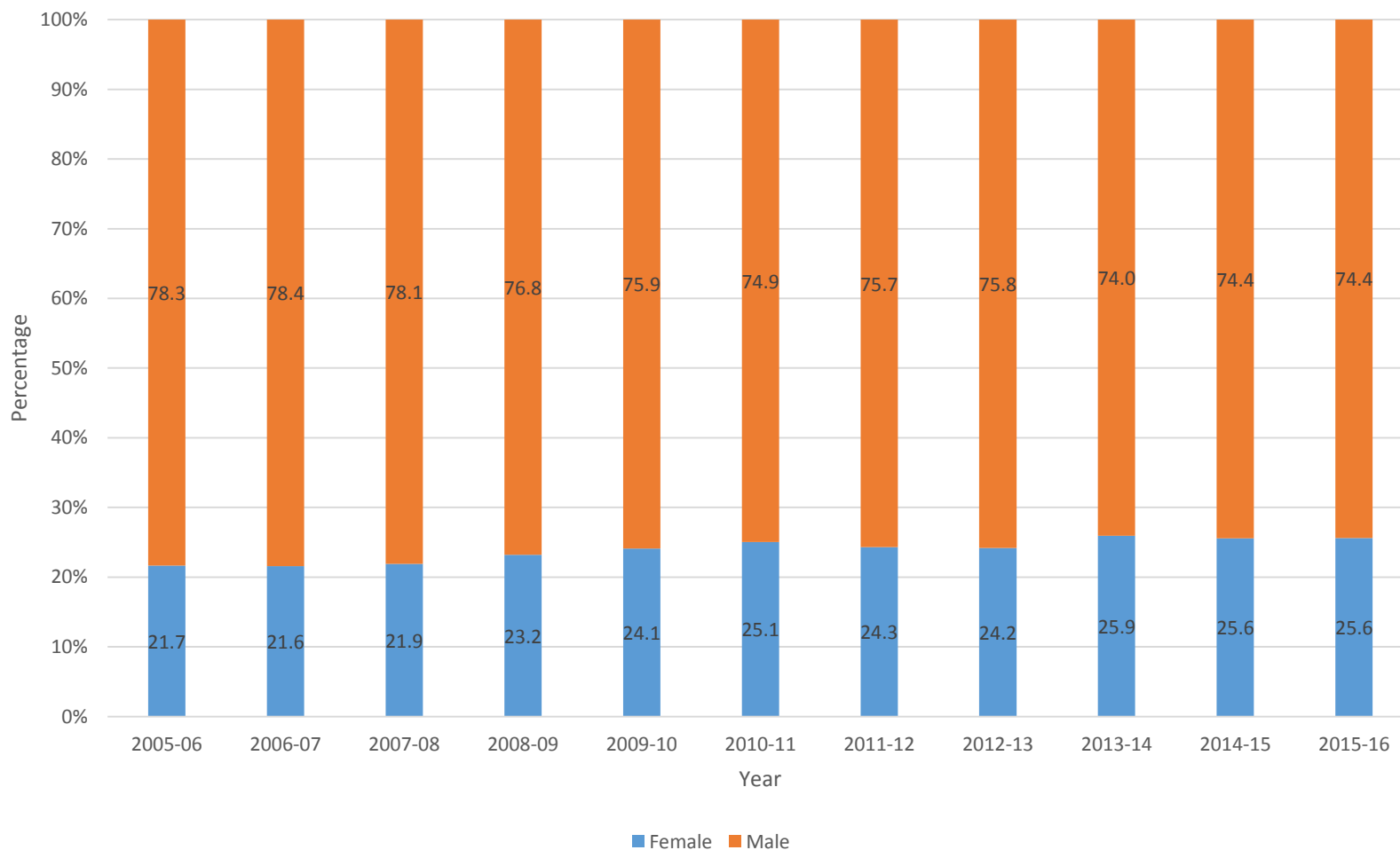


Figure 3: Sentenced young offenders by Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander status and year, 2005-06 to 2015-16

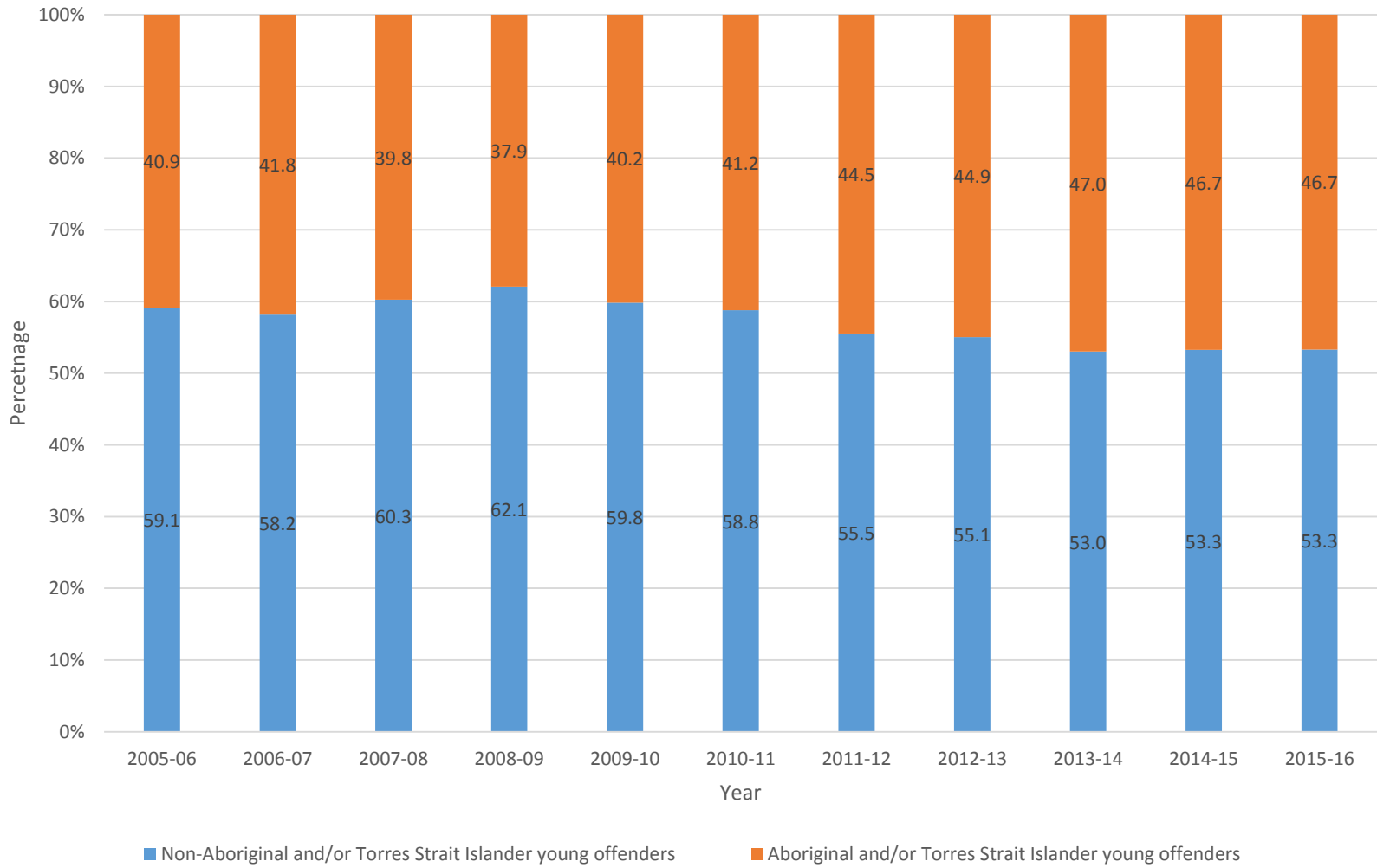
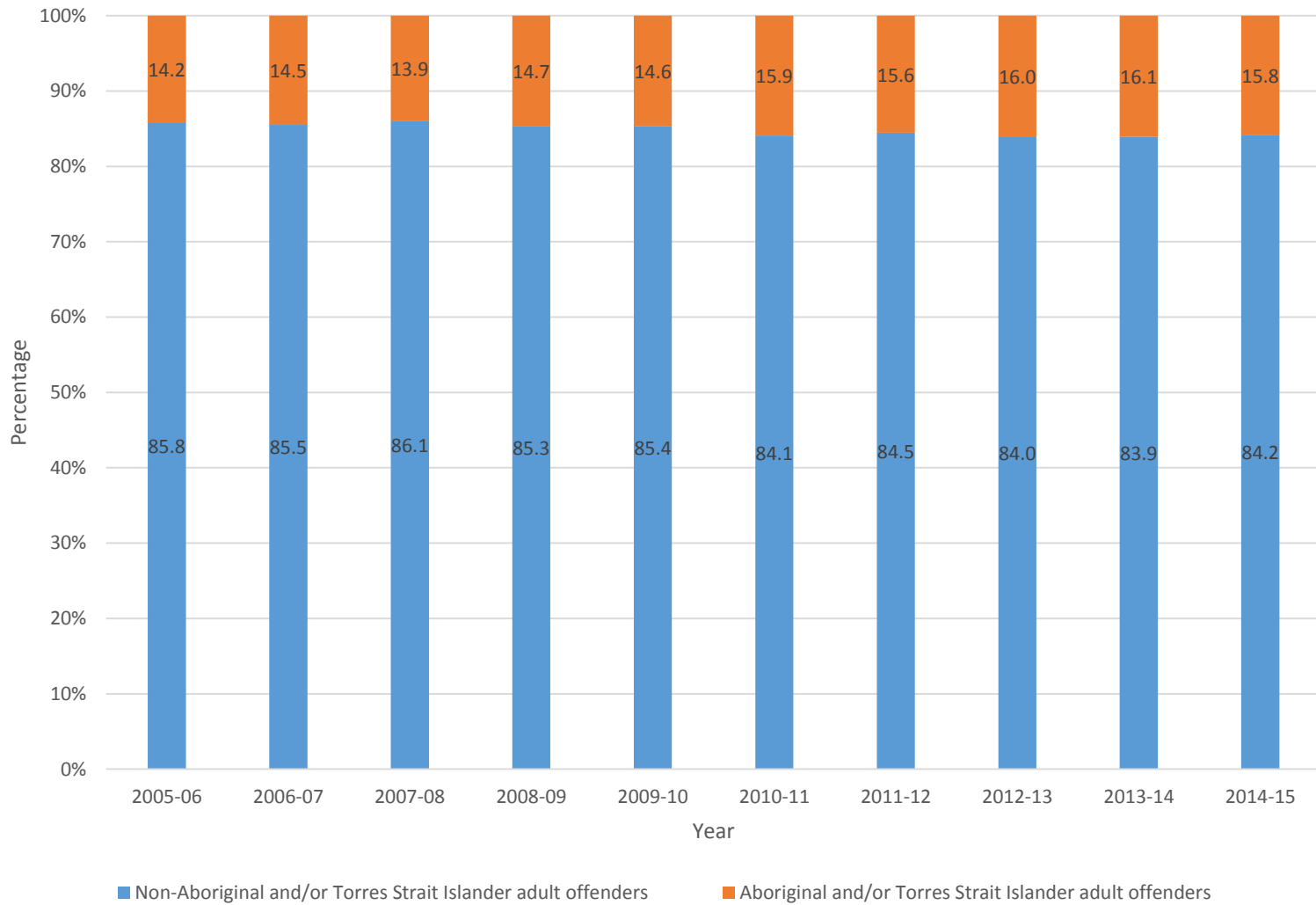


Figure 4: Sentenced adult offenders by Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander status and year, 2005-06 to 2015-16
