
## Sentencing Spotlight on... child exploitation material offences

There are a range of offences under both Queensland and Commonwealth legislation relating to the access, possession, distribution and making of child exploitation material. This *Sentencing Spotlight* looks at sentencing outcomes for child exploitation material offences finalised in the Queensland Courts between I July 2006 and 30 June 2016.


