
The act of intentionally or recklessly destroying or damaging property through the use of fire. **Maximum penalty** – life imprisonment


Other offences charged for similar behaviour:

endangering particular property by fire, and setting fire to crops and growing plants.

Maximum penalty - 14 years' imprisonment
